The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in GD/DDR No.24 dated 10.04.2025 registered under Sections 118(1), 125, 3(5) & 118(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Doraha, District Khanna (Ludhiana) in FIR No.44 dated 09.04.2025 registered under Sections 109, 115, 118(1), 118(2), 74, 351, 329(3), 324(4), 190, 125 & 191 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section 25 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Doraha, District Khanna (Ludhiana).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 14.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.
