By way of present petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners pray for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus by directing the respondents to restore the basic pension of the petitioners, as the impugned order dated 17.09.2024 (Annexure P10) vide which the revised pension under para 5.1(a) of the notification dated 29.10.2021 was stopped, has already been set aside by this Court vide an order dated 24.10.2024 (Annexure P16) in CWP No.28155 of 2024.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Jantider Singh Gill, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 3. Mr. Rajesh Sehgal, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2.

4. Learned State Counsel has placed on record copy of the order dated 28.01.2025 passed by a Division Bench of this Court in LPA No.201 of 2015-Punjab State Power Corporaon Limited Vs. Krishan Lal Batra and others, and submits that order dated 24.10.2024 (Annexure P16) was challenged before the



Division Bench in which notice of motion has been issued to respondent-State of Punjab only.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he may be granted the same benefit as granted vide order dated 24.10.2024 (Annexure P16). To that extent, learned counsel for the respondents have no objection.

6. As such, the present petition is hereby disposed of, by granting liberty to the respondents to take further necessary action, if any required, after complying with the principles of natural justice and on receipt of the clarification from the State Government. The pension which the petitioners were getting before passing the impugned order shall be restored to the petitioners.
