Prayer in the application is for impleadment of the LR's of the petitioner-Surjit Singh (since deceased).

For the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed and LR's of the petitioner are impleaded for the purpose of pursuing the main case only. Amended Memo of Parties is taken on record.

Main case:

Prayer made in the present petition is for directing respondents No.2 and 3 to remove the encroachment over the common land of old well and its surrounding vacant area.

It is evident from the perusal of order sheets that the matter is being adjourned on the request of learned counsel for the petitioner or on account of his non-appearance since 18.07.2022. On 24.03.2023 a specific query as regards the maintainability of the instant writ petition to the counsel



for the petitioner was put up, whereupon he sought time to assist this Court on the said aspect. On the next date of hearing the matter was adjourned on the request of learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner pleading that he was not feeling well. The matter was thereafter taken up on 30.05.2023 when a written request for adjournment was circulated on behalf of the petitioner. The matter was adjourned yet again to 05.07.2023 but none appeared on behalf of the petitioner on the said date. Even today there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It seems that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing the present petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
