1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (BNSS), seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 323 dated 01.09.2024, registered under Sections 3(5) and 306 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (BNS), with subsequent addition of Sections 319, 61, 95, and 112 of BNS, at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar, District Hisar.

2. As per the case of the prosecution, Punam @ Kajal @ Preeti, wife of the petitioner (Ravi Shah) and another associate/friend, while working in the household of the complainant, namely Sharwan Kumar, are alleged to have committed theft of gold ornaments and diamond



jewellery worth approximately ₹55 lakhs and cash amounting to ₹32,000/- from the complainant's residence.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's wife is presently in judicial custody and that the petitioner has been implicated solely on the basis of her disclosure statement, wherein it is alleged that he sold the stolen articles in the State of Bihar, immediately after the commission of theft.

4. Learned State counsel has submitted a status report by way of an affidavit of Sh. Sunil Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Women and Safety, Hisar, which has been filed in Court today. Same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

Learned State counsel further submits that the petitioner is involved in 12 other criminal cases. The details of the said cases are as follows:

Considering the nature and seriousness of the allegations, the value of the stolen property, and the fact that the petitioner has been named by his own wife in her disclosure statement, coupled with his involvement in multiple other criminal cases, this Court does not find any merit in the present anticipatory bail petition and thus same is hereby dismissed.
