1. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner today in the Court.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents No.2 to 4-distribution licensee, after having instructions imparted to him by Er. Iqbal Singh, AEE, informs this Court, to the effect that the house of the petitioner was found to be demolished, and it was also revealed on enquiry, that the petitioner was found to have died, way back on 03.12.2011.
3. Learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 4, has also placed on record the copy of death certificate, *qua* Iqbal Singh Brar (petitioner herein), today in the Court, which is in vernacular. The same is taken on record as 'Mark-A'.
