1. Petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the impugned order dated 22.09.2016, Annexure P-11, passed by the learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Ludhiana, whereby application filed by the petitioner under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC read with Section 151 CPC, Annexure P-10, has been dismissed.
