1. Petitioner – Jagdish Singh @ Jagdish Singh Khalsa, aged about 50 years, has filed present petition for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR bearing No.110 dated 09.04.2024, under Sections 406 and 420 I.P.C., registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar.

2. On 05.12.2024, following order was passed:-
