The instant execution application has been filed under Order 21 Rule 10 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 for seeking execution of the judgment dated 20.09.2017 passed by this Court in CWP-22983-2014 directing the respondent-State to appoint the petitioner as Staff Nurse w.e.f. 04.05.2014 with all the consequential benefits except arrears of pay.

2 Vide order dated 21.10.2024, learned State counsel was directed to seek instructions as to whether any stay had been granted against the judgment passed by this Court in LPA-356-2018.

3           On the resumed hearing today, learned State counsel informs that there is no such interim order that has been passed so far and that he has instructions to state that the benefits in terms of the order passed by this Court on 20.09.2017 shall be extended to the petitioner within a period of 15 days from today without prejudice to the rights of the petitioner and subject to final outcome in LPA-356-2018. A copy of letter dated 09.01.2025 conveying that the petitioner will be granted the benefit of appointment as per order dated 20.09.2017 passed in CWP-22983-2014 has also been placed on file which is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

4           In view of the aforesaid statement, the present execution application is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
