JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioners who are family members of Natha Singh through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India are seeking direction to respondents to regularize Natha Singh on the basis of different policies as well as his length of service.
2. Natha Singh worked with respondent for more than three decades and passed away on 03.07.2024. He during his life time did not file petition seeking regularization. The petitioners are claiming that as per applicable polices and judgments of Supreme Court, Natha Singh was entitled to benefit of regularization and consequential benefits. They have served Legal Notice dated 24.10.2024 on the respondent but to no avail.
3. Mr. Rakesh Roy, counsel for the respondents who on advance notice is present in Court submits that Competent Authority

would consider claim of petitioners in the light of applicable policies as well as judgments of Supreme Court.

4. In the wake of statement of Mr. Rakesh Roy, the present petition stands disposed of.

5. Let the needful be done within a period of six months from today. The respondent shall decide question of regularization within three months from today and if deceased employee is found entitled, the consequential benefits shall be determined within three months thereafter.
