1. Prayer in the instant petition is for directing the respondents to consider and adjudicate upon the application dated 08.05.2023 submitted by the petitioner for compassionate appointment on account of death of his father.
2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in case the respondent-Authorities are directed to look into the representation dated 04.04.2024 (Annexure P-2) and the grievance espoused by the mother of the petitioner therein and a speaking order is passed thereupon in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.
