After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the appellant seeks permission to withdraw the present appeal with liberty to raise all these issues for reducing the maintenance amount granted in favour of the respondent/wife in the proceedings under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the Act') vide impugned order dated 29.08.2023, firstly taking into account the factor that income of the appellant/husband has been reduced, in course of time; and secondly, the income of the appellant/husband was not the same during the period of Corona pandemic, by filing an appropriate application before the learned Family Court.

2. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid. In case, such an application is made by the appellant, the learned Family Court shall consider the same after getting evidence recorded and affording opportunity to the

respondent/wife to rebut the same, and pass an appropriate order, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
