1. This 2nd petition has been filed under Section 483 of The Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, for grant of regular bail to the petitioner(s) in FIR bearing No.206 dated 11.05.2020, registered under Section(s) 302 and 34 (Sections 201, 120-B and 195 added later on and Section 34 deleted later on) of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Ambala, District Ambala (Haryana).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the present case is based on the circumstantial evidence and the petitioner has already undergone an actual custody of 05 years, 04 months and 22 days. He further contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case.

3. Learned counsel for respondent-State, however, contends that the prosecution evidence is on the verge of completion and only 01 witness remains to be examined out of the total of 24 initially cited by the



prosecution. She further contends that next date before the trial Court is 23.10.2025 for remaining prosecution evidence.

4. Taking note of the stage of the trial which is on the verge of completion, the present petition is **disposed of** with a direction to the trial Court to conclude the prosecution evidence within a period of 02 months from the next date fixed before it.
