In the petition under Section 528 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (B.N.S.S.), 2023, the prayer is for setting aside the impugned order dated 27.05.2025 (Annexure P-7), passed by the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Amritsar in execution application bearing case No.Exe. 128 Cr.P.C.-59-2024 (CNR No.PBAS010042712024), whereby conditional warrants of the petitioner were issued in the sum of Rs.2,75,000/-.

After submitting arguments for some time learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from petitioner-Inderpal Singh, who is present in the Court, states that the petitioner is willing to pay the entire arrears due in execution application bearing case No.Exe. 128 Cr.P.C.-59-2024 (CNR No.PBAS010042712024) pending before learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Amritsar. He prays that only 15 days time be granted to him to make the entire payment and seeks permission to withdraw the petition.

Learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Amritsar shall consider the request of the petitioner/father to make the payment of entire arrears of maintenance allowance within 15 days.
