The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 16.05.2014. As per the said order, the petitioners were directed to accept the amount of compensation lying in the Treasury without prejudice to their right to seek compensation under the new Act.

Admittedly, on the said date the compensation lying with the Treasury was Rs. 14,86,238/-. The learned counsel states that they did not accept as no interest has been paid.

There was no direction regarding interest in the order dated 16.05.2014. Hence, no contempt is made out.

Dismissed accordingly.
