Prayer in the instant writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to issue the passport in the name of the petitioner in pursuance of passport application dated 25.10.2024 (Annexure P-7) and in view of representation (Annexure P-11).

2. At the outset, learned counsel for respondents/UOI submits that the instant writ petition has become infructuous as the passport of petitioner has already been dispatched to him.
