1. Prayer in this petition filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is for setting aside the impugned order dated 17.03.2025 (Annexure P/18) passed by Ld. Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Barnala wherein supplementary challan dated 10.10.2024, declaring the petitioner innocent on the basis of investigation reports dated 23.07.2024 and 11.08.2024 (Annexures P/12 and P/13) respectively, has been rejected and summoning the petitioner in FIR No.03 dated 06.06.2017, under Sections 498-A and 406 IPC, registered at Police Station NRI, District Sangrur.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since the matter has been compromised between the parties and order of even date for quashing of the aforementioned FIR has been passed in **CRM-M-51773-2025**, titled as "**Jodh Singh Sidhu and others Vs. State of Punjab and another**", the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same be disposed of such.

3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
