1. Present petition has been filed praying for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.14, dated 15.05.2024, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B, 465, 384 of IPC and Sections 66-C and 66-D of IT Act, registered at Police Station Cyber Crime, Mohali. Further prayer has been made for staying the arrest of the petitioner during the pendency of the present petition.

2. Status report dated 30.06.2025 by way of an affidavit of Simranjeet Singh, PPS, S. P., State Cyber Crime, Punjab, Phase-IV, SAS Nagar (Mohali) on behalf of the respondent-State has already been filed by the learned State counsel, which is taken on record.

3. Vide order dated 09.07.2025, while granting the interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 09.07.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Inspector Daljit Singh, has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

6. In view of the above, interim order dated 09.07.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023.

7. Petition stands allowed.
