1. The present petition is for seeking directions to the respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his family members at the hands of private respondents and take legal action against them in pursuance to FIR No.67 dated 08.05.2025 under Sections 115 (2), 326 (f), 74, 190, 191 (3) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Ramdas, District Amritsar Rural.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that some of respondents i.e. respondent Nos.5 to 12 are hardcore criminals and are bent upon to grab the property of the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Amandeep Singh Samra, AAG, Punjab, accepts notice on

behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 4.

5. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner at length.

6. Considering the nature of order to be passed, detailed reply from the respondents is not required at this stage. The present petition is only considered with regard to protection of life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his family members, however, the allegations with regard to property of the petitioner which the private respondents are trying to grab are left open and the petitioner is at liberty to seek appropriate remedy in accordance with law.

As regards the protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members is concerned, respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), District Amritsar, is directed to look into the representation dated 28.06.2025 (Annexure P-7) moved by the petitioner expeditiously and ensure that peace and harmony is maintained.

8. Disposed of in above terms.

9. Pending miscellaneous application(s) shall stand disposed of.
