Challenge in the present petition is to the order dated 21.05.1999 passed by the EPF Appellate Tribunal whereby the Food Corporation of India had been excluded within the provision of Section 16(1)(b) or (c) of the EPF & MP Act, 1952.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that they have not been able to contact their clients despite best efforts and no instructions are forth coming, she contends that the petitioner-Union may have no further subsisting interest in pursuing the present writ petition.
