1. Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 528 BNSS, vide which she has prayed to issue directions to respondent No.2 to decide the complaint dated 22.01.2025 (Annexure P-1), filed by her against private respondent No.3.
2. Contents of the petition reveal that petitioner is a homemaker, residing on the ground floor of the house bearing No.118, Abadi Ghanupur Kala, Amritsar, whereas respondent No.3 along with her children is residing on the first floor. On 23.12.2024, petitioner had gone to visit her relatives. When she returned back on the following day i.e. 24.12.2024, she found that theft had been committed. Even the CCTV cameras installed in her house were found damaged. Petitioners had given complaint dated 22.01.2025 (Annexure P-1) to the local police officials but till date no action thereon has been taken.
3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.



4. Upon a call given by Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association, the Members of the Bar are abstaining from work.

5. In view of the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits thereof, the same is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 – Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to consider and dispose of the complaint dated 22.01.2025 (Annexure P-1) within a period of two weeks, in accordance with law. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioner as well.
