Application for condonation of 948 days' delay in filing the appeal.

Notice of the application to the non-applicant/respondent.

Ms. Gurpreet Kaur, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the non-applicant/respondent and raises no objection to the present application.

In view of the above and for the reasons mentioned in the application, the same is allowed subject to all just exceptions. Delay of 948 days in filing the appeal is condoned.

MAIN CASE

Present appeal has been filed by wife under Section 19 of the Family Courts Act, 1984 against the impugned judgment and decree dated 10.02.2022, passed by learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Tarn Taran, vide



which petition filed under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (*for short 'Act'*) was allowed and decree of divorce by way of mutual consent was passed.

(2) This appeal has been preferred solely on the ground that parties have decided to live together and they in fact are residing happily since January, 2024 and this fact is duly acknowledged after instructions by both learned Counsel for the parties.

(3) In view of the above, present appeal is allowed; impugned judgment and decree dated 10.02.2022, passed on the basis of mutual consent, are hereby set aside. Parties are at liberty to live together as wife and husband, respectively.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
