1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 30.11.2017, in CWP-25546-2017.

2. At the outset, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent states that benefits as per entitlement in terms of order Annexure P/1 have been deposited in the account of the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondent, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to move an application for revival of the instant petition in the eventuality of any shortfall in the payment made.

4. The same is not opposed to by the learned counsel for the respondent.

5. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of

Courts Act, 1971, with the liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
