The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to complete the service record and give all benefits to the petitioners.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage, the petitioners will be satisfied in case they are permitted to make a fresh representation before the respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Deepak Vashisth, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State, and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioners within one week from today, the same will be decided by the second respondent/Director, Elementary Education, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within a period of three months of receiving the representation.



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioners has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioners.
