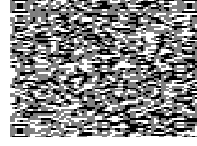

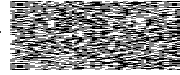
VIKAS SURI, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in this petition is for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for willful disobedience of the order dated 12.05.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP 4650-2024.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Karan Kumar Jund, Senior Panel Counsel for UOI, is present in Court on an advance copy of the petition having been served upon the respondents and he accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and waives service. Reply/compliance affidavit dated 22.07.2025 of Lt. Col Garima Awasthi, Adm. Comdt. Stn. HQ, Military Station; Faridkot officiating as OIC, ECHS (Cell) Station Headquarters, Military Station, Faridkot has been filed in the Court today. A copy thereof stands furnished to learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Referring to the compliance affidavit, learned counsel for the respondents submits that the Writ Court while adjourning the case of the petitioner *sine die*, granted interim relief to the petitioner in terms of order dated 05.03.2024 passed by the Division Bench in LPA-637-2024. It is further submitted that in deference to the order dated 05.03.2024 (Annexure P-2), the appointment letter has since been issued.
