The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 482 of B.N.S.S with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.45, dated 08.04.2025, under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B of IPC and Section 82 of Registration Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala, Punjab (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 29.05.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.
3. Learned State counsel has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.
