1. The respondent-plaintiff had filed a suit for mandatory injunction directing the present appellants to give promotion to the respondent-plaintiff as Inspector, Food and Supplies. The said suit was dismissed and the appeal against the said judgment was allowed and the suit filed by the plaintiff was decreed.

2. A perusal of the paperbook would show that there is no interim order in favour of the present appellants.

3. As per the report of the registry, sole respondent has died.

4. Learned counsel for the appellants has submitted that in all probability, the respondent would have retired before having died and as per his instructions, even the mother and wife of the respondent have died and in view of the same, present appeal be disposed of at this stage but liberty be granted to the appellants to revive the appeal, in case, any cause of action survives.

5. In view of the same, present appeal is disposed of at this stage with the aforesaid liberty.
