1. Apprehending threat to their life and liberty, both the petitioners have filed the present petition with a prayer to direct the official respondents to decide the representation dated 15.09.2025 (Annexure P-6).

2. The facts, as can be inferred from the petition, are as follows: Both the petitioners, who are major, got married to each other in accordance with Sikh rites and ceremonies on 13.09.2025. Their relationship was not approved of by their parents and they expressed their unhappiness. It is in this backdrop that the present petition has been filed by the petitioners.

3. Upon a call given by Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Association, the Members of the Bar are abstaining from work.

4. In view of the documents available on record and the averments made in the petition, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib, to decide the representation dated 15.09.2025 (Annexure P-6) within a period of two weeks. In case, it is found that



there is a genuine threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners, then necessary steps warranted under law be taken at the earliest, so as to ensure that no harm is caused to the petitioners.

5. It is, however, clarified that this order shall not be taken to be any expression as regards the alleged marriage of the petitioners and shall not confer any immunity upon the petitioners, in case it is found that they have committed any wrong.
