1.             Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has requested respondent No.1 to correct the marksheet of the petitioner issued in the year 2021 dated 03.08.2021, copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-1 so as to amend the name of the father of the petitioner to be recorded as “Uttam Singh” instead of “Uttam” as the same is only a typographical error and nothing more.

2.             Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already approached the respondents for the said amendment by filing representations Annexure P-6 and Annexure P-7 but the said representations are still pending consideration and petitioner will be satisfied in case, the same are decided in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.
4. On advance notice, Mr. Beant Singh Seemar, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-CBSE by filing his memo of appearance. The same is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondent-CBSE submits that the representations filed by the petitioner dated 31.10.2023 and 13.09.2024, copies of which have been appended as Annexure P-6 and Annexure P-7 will be decided within a period of *4 weeks* from today by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner as per the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in ***Civil Appeal No.3905 of 2011 titled "Jigyaa Yadav Vs. Central Board of Secondary Education and ors."***, ***decided on 03.06.2021***, the prayer of the petitioner will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed and the said order will be duly conveyed to the petitioner for his information and necessary action.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
