Mr. Nigam K. Bhardwaj, Advocate has filed Memorandum of Appearance to represent the respondent-Insurance company.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant, learned counsel and representative of the respondent – Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs.10,00,000/- (Rs. Ten Lacs Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

Accordingly, we **dispose of** this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.10,00,000/- in the name of appellant Vitender Kumar with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of two months in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
