1. Prayer in this petition, filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023, is for issuing directions to respondent No. 2-DGP, Haryana to conduct fair inquiry on the application dated 30.09.2024 (Annexure P1) submitted by the petitioner and to take legal action against the accused by registering a criminal case.

2. At the very outset, learned Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana has submitted that due inquiry was conducted on the aforesaid application of the petitioner and the same has been filed on 10.11.2024 as no substance was found therein. Rather, a case under Section 182 of IPC has been registered against him. It is further submitted that the petitioner himself is a man of criminal antecedents as he was involved in 23 FIRs, out of

which, in some of the FIRs, he has been convicted and in some cases, he has been acquitted. A list of such cases has been placed on record. It is, thus, urged that the petition is liable to be dismissed.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner could not dispute the factual position.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts as well as the criminal antecedents of the petitioner, no case is made out to issue any direction to the official respondents. Hence, the petition is dismissed.

5. However, the petitioner is granted liberty to avail his alternative remedies in accordance with law.
