1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.139 dated 13.09.2020, registered under Section 498-A IPC, at Police Station Tibber, District Gurdaspur (Annexure P-1) and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 19.08.2023 (Annexure P-2) executed between the parties.

2. On the last date of hearing, the following order was passed:-

“Vide last order dated 23.04.2024 passed by this Court, the parties were directed to appear before the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, for recording their statements qua genuineness of compromise.

Pursuant thereto, report from the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurdaspur, vide letter dated 25.07.2024, duly forwarded by the learned District and



Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur, has been received, wherein it has been reported that 'none of the parties appeared in the Court for recording their statements with regard to compromise as directed by this Court vide order dated 01.03.2024 and 23.04.2024'.

There is no representation either on behalf of the petitioner or respondent No. 2-complainant, despite the case having been called twice.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 22.11.2024.

3. Today also none has put in appearance for the petitioner as well as for respondent No.2-complainant. It appears that the petitioner is no more interested to pursue the present petition.

4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
