1. The present revision petition has been instituted under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, for setting aside the impugned order dated 27.05.2025 passed by the Court of learned Additional District Judge, Fatehabad (Annexure P-9) in civil appeal bearing **Case No.CA-122 of 2025** captioned as "**Reena Mahant vs. Joji Mahant**" vide which interim relief has been granted in an appeal against the order rejection of plaint under Order 7 Rule 11 CPC in favour of respondent/plaintiff.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction may be given to the Additional District Judge, Fatehabad, for deciding the stay application as expeditiously as possible and in the meanwhile, the impugned order dated 27.05.2025 may be stayed.
3. In view of the order proposed to be passed, notice is not being issued to respondent as it would delay the proceedings besides entailing additional expenses to the respondent-plaintiff.
4. I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and have gone through the paper book.

Considering the aforesaid facts, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of and learned Additional District Judge, Fatehabad, is directed to decide the stay application as expeditiously as possible and in the meanwhile, operation of impugned order dated 27.05.2025 shall remain stayed.
