By way of order dated 14.05.2025 Writ Court disposed off the writ petition directing respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali to look into the representation and to take appropriate action, if any required.

2. Though there was no direction to decide the representation, still the petitioner has approached this Court by way of present petition filed under Section 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 claiming wilful disobedience of the order dated 14.05.2025.

3. In the considered opinion of this Court, once there is no direction to decide the representation and obviously the same cannot be in view of the fact that under BNSS or for that matters under Cr.P.C., police authorities have no power to decide the complaints, the present contempt



petition is misconceived. However, counsel for the respondent has produced copy of the order dated 23.06.2025 purported to have been passed pursuant to the direction issued by this Court.

4. In view thereof, no further order is required to be passed.
5. The instant concept petition is disposed off.
