1. Separate compliance reports by way of affidavits of Sh. Himanshu Aggarwal, Deputy Commissioner, Jalandhar and Sh. Satwinder Singh, Tehsildar, Phillaur, District Jalandhar have been filed in Court, the same are taken on record.

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from Sh. Jaswinder Singh, Tehsildar, Phillaur submits that arrears of GIS and leave encashment shall be released in favour of the petitioner by tomorrow, whereas the GPF and pension shall be released within one week from today. He also assures that as per rules interest shall also be released in favour of the petitioner against the delayed disbursement of retiral benefits.

3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking by the respondent(s), learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition.

4. Dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

5. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring/concerned officer would be liable to pay a sum of Rs.50,000/- as cost(s) from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
