The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari for setting aside the order dated 06.03.2025 (Annexure P-11) passed by learned Financial Commissioner (Appeals), Punjab; and *Sanad Taksim* (Annexure P-10); orders dated 05.01.2021 (Annexure P-9), 04.11.2020 (Annexure P-8), 31.01.2019 (Annexure P-7), 05.10.2012 (Annexure P-6), 19.09.2012 (Annexure P-5) and 02.03.2012 (Annexure P-4) passed by the learned Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Patiala.

1.1. A further prayer has been made for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the official respondents to finalize the partition proceedings only after hearing the petitioners herein.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there are some inadvertent errors in the instant writ petition, therefore, he may be permitted to withdraw the same with liberty to the petitioners to file a fresh one with better particulars.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submission made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

4. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
