Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that contempt proceedings be initiated against the respondent(s) for not complying the order dated 28.5.2019 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP-12541-2019 titled as “Deepak Kumar and others vs. State of Haryana and others”, vide which while issuing notice of motion, the interim order was granted in terms of CWP-19583-2018.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that necessary compliance has been made, and in that regard handed over a copy of the communication dated 10.7.2025 issued by the Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. of Haryana, Higher Education



Department, Chandigarh; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.

Copy of the aforesaid communication dated 10.7.2025 produced by the learned counsel for the respondent-State is taken on record. Copy thereof is supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner(s). Registry to tag/paginate the same at appropriate place in the paper-book.

Learned counsel for the petitioners also submits that the order dated 28.5.2019 (Annexure P-1) has been complied with.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition, the same is **disposed of** accordingly.

The petitioner would be at liberty to challenge the aforesaid communication/Order dated 10.7.2025 as per law.
