Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to consider the recruitment and dispatch of the petitioners to the training Centres as they have been duly selected "Soldiers General Duty" during Army Recruitment Rally held at Ferozepur from 27.08.2018 to 08.09.2018 as similarly situated candidates have been dispatched for training.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that with regard to their grievance(s), the petitioners have got served a legal notice dated 27.03.2025 (Annexure P-17) but the respondents have neither responded to the same nor have they taken any action upon the said legal notice.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Brijeshwar Singh Kanwar, Advocate enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if so advised.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, however, contends that he would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.2- Director Recruiting, Army Recruiting Office, Ferozpur Cantt. District Ferozpur is directed to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.03.2025 (Annexure P-17) served by the petitioner, by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

Learned Counsel for the respondents does not have any objection to the request made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

Accordingly, in view of the above; with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of while directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.03.2025 (Annexure P-17) by passing a reasoned and speaking order after affording an opportunity of hearing to the respective parties within a period of four months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.
