The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under section 528 of BNSS for issuance of directions to the respondents no. 1 to 5 to conduct fair and impartial investigation qua the representations dated 07.03.2025 (Annexure P-2 and P-3) and to take necessary legal action i.e. registration of FIR, in view of law laid down by Hon'ble Supreme court in *Lalita Kumari Vs. State of U.P*, as the cognizable offence has been committed, which is an offence against the state.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he will be satisfied in case a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to look into the representations dated 07.03.2025 (Annexures P-2 & P-3) , within a time bound manner.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2/Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka to look into the representations dated 07.03.2025 (Annexures P-2 & P-3) and decide the same in accordance with law within a period of four weeks by passing a speaking order.

A copy of order so passed be supplied to the petitioner within one week thereafter.
