1. The petitioner had filed the present petition under Section 482 BNSS with a prayer to grant of anticipatory bail to him in case FIR No.46 dated 15.05.2025, registered under Sections 115(2), 118(2), 3(5) of the BNS, 2023, Police Station Chattiwind, District Amritsar Rural.

2. The FIR in the present case was registered on the basis of the statement made by Charanjit Singh and the same has been reproduced below:-

“Statement of Charanjit Singh S/o Lal Singh R/o Rajewal P.S. Chattiwind District Amritsar age about 52 years mobile no. 9646963839 stated that I am resident of above address and is working as farmer. I have two sons and two daughters. I am getting my house constructed at my village Rajewal and the roof of



which was to be made on 04.05.2025 and on that I had invited my relatives and the house of my masi Bir Kaur W/o Sardul Singh R/o Rajewal is nearby my house and on 03.05.2025 at about 9:30 night I was going to the house of my masi Bir Kaur for inviting her at my place. I after knocking the door of the house of my masi was waiting that in the meantime Lovepreet Singh @ Lalla S/o Major Singh R/o Rajewal having datar, Gurpreet Singh @ Gaggu S/o Partap Singh R/o Amarkot having baseball, Vanshdeep Singh @ Kaka S/o Major Singh @ Tona R/o Rajewal having daang and two other unknown persons who were having baseball and daang came towards me. That lovejeetsingh @ lalla above raised lalkara and said that get hold of Charanjeet and teach him lesson for not letting us acquire the government land. In the meantime lovejeet gave datar blow on me which hit on my nose due to which I fell down on ground. Gurpreet Singh gave baseball blow on me which hit on the backside of my head and Vanshdeep gave dang blow on me which hit on my waist and unknown persons gave blows with their weapons to me which hot me on my waist and right leg. I raised alarm of maar dita maar dita and in the meantime above persons ran from the place along with their weapons. after raising hue and cry, my family came on the spot. My nephew Shamsher Singh S/o Jaspal Singh R/o Rajewal arranged vehicle and got me admitted in civil hospital manawala. Dr informed the injuries to be serious referred me to guru nanak dev hospital Amritsar where I have been under medical treatment till 06.05.2025. on 06.05.2025 Dr. referred me to civil hospital manawala. From date 06.05.2025 to 09.05.2025 I have been admitted in civil hospital manawala. Legal action be taken against above persons. MLR has been submitted. Statement have been recorded to you. I have found it to be true after reading. I am responsible. SD/- Charanjit Singh endorsed SD/- Palwinder Singh above verified SD/- Harpal Singh ASI I-CPP Daburji P.S. Chattiwind date 15.05.2025.”



3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case, the occurrence had allegedly taken place on 03.05.2025 and the FIR was registered after a long delay of 12 days i.e. 15.05.2025. He further contends that the petitioner has been attributed two blows with the dang on the waist and right leg of the complainant. He further contends that as per the medical record, both the injuries have been declared to be simple in nature. The petitioner is a young boy and his whole career is at stake.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel has vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that serious allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner and he does not deserve the concession of bail by this Court. However, he admits that the injuries, which are attributed to the petitioner have been declared to be simple in nature. He has also filed short reply by way of an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Attari, Amritsar (Rural), on behalf of the respondent-State and the same is taken on record.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

6. In the present case, the petitioner was allegedly carrying a *dang* and had caused injuries to the complainant, which have been declared to be simple in nature. Even the petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

7. Thus, without commenting any further, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail, subject to the conditions as provided under Sections 482 (2) of B.N.S.S. It will be open for the Investigating Officer to call the petitioner to join the investigation, if so



required, by issuing a written notice in this regard and they shall abide by the conditions mentioned in Section 482 (2) of B.N.S.S.
