1. Present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS seeking issuance of directions to official respondents No. 1 to 3 for conducting fair and impartial inquiry in FIR No. 329 dated 05.07.2024 (Annexure P-1) registered under Sections 447, 427, 506 of Indian Penal Code and Section 3(1) of The Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala, within stipulated time and further seeking directions to official respondents to submit the status report within stipulated period before this Court.
2. Learned State counsel has filed status report dated 04.03.2025 in the Court today. Same is taken on record. Be tagged at the appropriate place.
3. Learned State counsel at the very outset, on instructions from Investigating Officer submits that nothing survives in the present petition as the Investigating Agency has already concluded the investigation and submitted the final report before the learned jurisdictional Court on 25.02.2025.
