1. Present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.65 dated 21.06.2024 under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City-2 Abohar, District Fazilka as well as Challan under Section 193 of BNSS adding Sections 27-A and 29 of NDPS Act, dated 08.02.2025, Police Station City-2 Abohar, District Fazilka and other consequential proceedings arising out of the same.

2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the challan has been presented but charges are yet to be framed.

3. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to avail alternative remedy as available to him under the law.

4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn. However, trial Court is directed to take into consideration the submissions made by the petitioner as the challan has been presented and would assess whether any *prima facie* case is made out against the petitioner or not.
