



3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and has no serious objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, at this stage.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record carefully.

6. At this stage, this Court deems it appropriate to direct the respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 02.06.2025 (Annexure P-13) submitted by the petitioner, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

7. While deciding the representation, the respondent No.1 shall take into consideration the law laid down by the Hon’ble Supreme Court in the matter of State of Punjab and others Vs. Jagjit Singh and others, 2016 (4) SCT 641” and “Sabha Shankar Dubey Vs. Divisional Forest Officer & others, 2019(1) SCT 46”.

8. It is expected that respondent No.2 shall pass a speaking and well reasoned order and in case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled to any consequential relief, the same shall be allowed along with reasonable rate of interest, thereon.
