No one has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner even on second call today.

2. On the last date of hearing also, no one appeared on behalf of the petitioner to argue the matter.

3. This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to initiate appropriate legal action against respondents No.4 and 5 who forcibly tried to abduct the 8 years old daughter of the petitioner.

4. Learned State counsel while placing reliance upon the status report submits that the preliminary investigation in the aforesaid case/complaint was conducted by ASI-Gurcharan Kaur (CAW and C-Cell, Zone-II, Ludhiana) during which the statements of both the parties i.e. the petitioner and respondent No.4 were recorded, which revealed that the petitioner and respondent No.4 have been living separately and subsequent to their separation, the children of the petitioner and respondent No.4 i.e. a

boy (aged 6 years) and girl (aged 8 years) are residing with the petitioner. Additionally, it was noted that respondent No.4-wife had filed a petition under Section 125 of Cr.P.C. bearing case No.MNT/2052 of 2019 against the petitioner, which is currently under consideration before the learned Family Court, Ludhiana. After the preliminary investigation, the concerned authority came to the conclusion that no credible evidence, supporting the allegations as leveled by the petitioner against respondents No.4 and 5, could be found and a detailed report was submitted which was duly approved by the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana.

5. In view of submissions made by learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed in the matter and the present petition is dismissed as infructuous accordingly.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
