The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of *Certiorari*, for setting aside the orders dated 30.08.2024 (Annexure P-2), 28.11.2024 (Annexure P-4), 11.02.2025 (Annexure P-6) and 07.03.2025 (Annexure P-8), passed by learned Sub Divisional Canal Officer, learned Divisional Canal Officer, Narwana, learned Superintending Canal Officer, Kaithal and learned Chief Canal Officer, Panchkula, respectively.
