**HARPREET KAUR JEEWAN, J. (Oral)**

[1] The prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to respondents No. 1 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of private respondents Nos. 6 to 13, who had got married against the wishes of private respondents.

[2] The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1-Mandeep Kaur, aged about 18 years and petitioner No.2-Vikram, aged about 29 years have got married on 06.10.2025 according to Hindu rites and ceremonies against the wishes of respondents No.6 to 13, who are parents of petitioner No.1, as per marriage certificate dated 06.10.2025 (Annexure P-3). However, they are apprehending threat from the hands of respondents No.6 to 13. The petitioners feeling imminent danger to their life and liberty, submitted a written representation dated 06.10.2025 (Annexure P-5) to respondent Nos.2 to 5, but till date no police protection has been provided to the petitioners and they are facing constant threat from the private respondents No.6 to 13.

[4] On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harshit Singla, AAG, Haryana, who is present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 5.

[5] In support of petitioners being major, they have filed the photocopies of their Aadhar Cards and an affidavit of petitioner No.1 in support of the averments made in the petition wherein petitioner No.1- Mandeep Kaur has alleged her date of birth as 27.09.2007 and petitioner No.2-Vikram has alleged his date of birth as 16.09.1996. Apart from this, copy of the marriage certificate and the representation given to respondent Nos.2 to 5 have also been placed on record.

[6] In view of this, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 & 3 to look into the representation dated 06.10.2025, *qua* threat perception and if there is any substance in it, take necessary steps, in accordance with law, to ensure that life and liberty of petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents.

[7] This order may not be construed as an opinion regarding validity of the marriage alleged to have been solemnized by the petitioners.

[8] Further, it is made clear that if any of the averments made in the petition is found to be incorrect, specifically with regard to age of the petitioners or the petitioners being in any prohibited relationship to each other, or as regards their previous marital status, this order shall not be construed to be a bar on proceedings to be initiated as per law.

[9] Pending miscellaneous applications, if any, shall stand disposed of.
