The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of B.N.S.S. with a prayer for directing the learned Court of Family Court (Principal Judge), Fatehabad for expedite the application filed by the petitioner under Section 340 read with Section 195(1)(B) and 195(4) Cr.P.C. during the pendency of petition filed by respondent under Section 125 Cr.P.C.

2. learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that, vide order dated 31.07.2025, the learned Family Court (Principal Judge), Fatehabad, recorded that the parties have consented to explore the possibility of an amicable settlement and have accordingly been referred to mediation.
