1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS, 2023 to the petitioner in case FIR No.251 dated 04.09.2023 under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Shahzadpur, District Ambala.
2. Vide order dated 11.02.2025 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rakesh Kumar has stated that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.
5. In view of the above, interim order dated 11.02.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023. Petition stands allowed.
