Challenge in the present writ petition is to the order dated 25.04.2025 issued by respondent No.3-Commissioner & Secretary to Mines & Geology Department, Chandigarh, Haryana vide which Gratuity and commuted value of pension of the petitioner was stopped until the conclusion of the departmental enquiry/chargesheets pending against the petitioner.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that, at this juncture, the petitioner would be satisfied in case respondent No.2-the Director Mines & Geology Department, Panchkula, Haryana is directed to decide the latest representation dated 28.04.2025 (Annexure P-10) and the grievance espoused by the petitioner therein by
