**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)**

In the light of the reply, which has been filed by the respondents, it appears that the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous.

Counsel for the petitioner, however, points out that one claim of the petitioner with regard to arrears of pay on account of revision of pay is still pending with the respondents.

If that be so, the petitioner may make a representation, highlighting and projecting therein the dues, to which as per him, he is entitled to and have not been paid to him, to the Executive Engineer, P&M, 220 KV Sub-Station, PSPTL, Sri Muktsar Sahib, within a period of four weeks from today. If such a representation is made, the same shall be considered and decided by the said authority within a period of six weeks of submission of such representation. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith. In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to him within a further period of four weeks.

The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of.
