1. Prayer in this writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondent No.5 to release the retiral benefits and other financial benefits to the petitioner, in accordance with the order dated 19.03.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.4 and order dated 17.05.2022 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.3 alongwith interest on the delayed payments. Further prayer has been made to direct respondent No.5 and 6 to decide the legal notice dated 25.07.2025 (Annexure P-4) served by the petitioner for releasing the retirement benefits as well as other financial benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied if the legal notice dated 25.07.2025 (Annexure P-4) of the



petitioner is decided by respondents No.5 and 6 by passing a speaking order in a time bound manner.

3. Learned State counsel, appearing on advance notice, submits that he has no objection, in case a direction is issued to the respondents No.5 and 6 for time-bound consideration and decision of the legal notice dated 25.07.2025 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner by passing a speaking order.

4. Therefore, in view of the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, respondents No.5 and 6 are directed to consider the legal notice dated 25.07.2025 (Annexure P-4) of the petitioner and pass a speaking order, after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner, within a period of 03 months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order. Further, the decision taken thereof shall be conveyed to the petitioner. Needless to say, if the petitioner is found entitled to the relief sought, the same shall be granted forthwith by respondents No.5 and 6.

5. Disposed of, accordingly.
